



## ACTIVITY 17: "Subtraction (set one die and roll two)"

### Purpose of the activity:

- Student will be able to add two numbers with a sum up to 19 and then subtract a one digit number from that sum.

### Materials needed:

- Two advanced black dice and one basic red die.

### How to play:

- Teacher sets one advanced black die at six and rolls the other advanced black die and the basic red die and has the Student add the two black dice together and then subtract the red die from that sum. Teacher could explain to the Student that if the number showing on the red die is the same as the number showing on either black die the answer will be the number on the other black die.

### Possible Next Steps/ When to Move On To Next Activity:

- When the Teacher is satisfied that the Student can do this problem accurately and without hesitation it is time to advance to doing the problem without setting any dice.
