



## ACTIVITY 2: “Number Recognition”

### Purpose of the activity:

- Student will be able to recognize and name numbers 2 through 13.

### Materials needed:

- One basic black die and one advanced black die. Pen and any chart (for writing number)

### How to play:

- **Variation 1:** Teacher sets\* or rolls one die (making sure to use both the basic die and advanced die) and has Student say what the number is that is showing on top of the die.
- **Variation 2:** Teacher sets or rolls one die and has Student write down the number that is showing on top of the die on the chart. (introducing writing numbers)

### Possible Next Steps/ When to Move On:

- Teacher discretion when Student can correctly identify all numbers 2 - 13. Having the Student write the number is intended to get the student acquainted with writing the number, but the student doesn't need to master this skill to move on.

*The term “set” when referring to the dice, means that the Teacher will choose a number that will be displayed on the die. This is so the Teacher can control what number the Student is working with.*
